We encourage international exchange

The International Office coordinate all international relations within the framework of the worldwide partner university network. We offer support in the following areas:

Student mobility: We support 200 incoming and outgoing students per year at bachelor and master level and advise them individually in all matters concerning semesters abroad, internships abroad, Erasmus+ and Summer School.

Erasmus+: The EU programme Erasmus+ provides financial and organisational support to our students and staff during their stays abroad in Europe (also outside Europe for specific projects). Our institution is the sponsor of the "Erasmus Charter for Higher Education 2021-2027" and publishes the Erasmus Policy Statement as an integral part of the internationalisation strategy.

Getting Started

Plan your stay

Requirements: Your home university needs to have a valid bilateral agreement for student exchange with us. Knowledge of the German language is not required for our English taught programmes.

Application process: Students have to be nominated by their home university as an exchange student by the application deadline: incomings.business@fhwn.ac.at After nomination, the application instructions will be sent to all applicants. In addition to the application form, the following documents have to be submitted: a copy of the passport, one passport photograph, a copy of an insurance policy (incl. emergency transportation back to home country in case of illness), the current transcript of records, proof of proficiency in English and the course selection sheet.

Entry and residency regulations:

Nationals of EU/EEA countries and Switzerland only need a valid travel document (passport or identity card) to enter and live in Austria. Nationals of all other countries have to apply for a residence visa D (stay between ninety-one days and six months) or a residence permit (stay longer than six months). For a visa you have to apply in person at the Austrian Embassy or Consulate-General in your home country. Visas cannot be extended in Austria. Campus 1 – hub for competence, practice & perspectives

This is where it all began: Campus 1 is the University's first and largest location and provides an extensive and modern educational choice with 18 programmes taught at four faculties Engineering, Health, Sport and Security, full-time or extra-occupational, in German and partly in English. By focussing on how to deal with the demands of the future, adopting both an active international outlook and practical relevance, we suitably prepare our students whatever their future career might demand, moulding them into highly sought-after graduates on the job market. Campus 1 of the University of Applied Sciences Wiener Neustadt also offers students a wide range of opportunities outside of the curriculum. International programmes taught in English

Aerospace Engineering (Master): This multidisciplinary programme is taught in a unique environment: leading aircraft manufacturers, an airport with aircraft and helicopters and research partner FOTEC are situated near the university.

MedTech (Master): This extra-occupational programme is unique in Europe. It is a part time programme, offered via distance learning, combining technical and physical aspects of functional imaging and therapy planning with its application in a medical environment.

Business Consultancy International (Bachelor & Master)

Business Consultancy International (BCi) is a broad business degree programme with an international focus, taught entirely in English.

It provides a stimulating environment in which students from many different nations and cultural backgrounds work alongside international teaching staff.

The study programme requires a great deal of interaction between you, your fellow students and your instructors, which increases intercultural understanding and cooperation. Our teaching staff are extremely cosmopolitan: Many of our lecturers are professionals in their field and work in international companies. In addition, a number of our staff come from foreign partner universities, including American, Canadian, Italian and Irish institutions, to teach courses in the BCi programme.

Bachelor's programme: Provides you with broad-based knowledge and skills. Specialisations: International Accounting and Finance (IAF), International Marketing

and Sales (IMS), International Management and Leadership (IML).

Master's programme: Prepares you for leadership roles by imparting highly specialized, expert level knowledge. Specialisations: Marketing Analytics, Treasury & Investment

Practice perspectives

Bachelor-programme: As a BCi graduate, you will be able to fulfil the requirements of the business community by means of perfect communication skills in English, intercultural understanding and global business know-how. The main activity in the sixth and final semester of the degree programme is an internship in a company approved by the university, either in Austria or abroad. The duration of the internship is at least 15 weeks and provides a great opportunity for work experience, networking, and even permanent employment. Both the company and the students are supported by the BCi team to ensure that everyone involved gets most out of the internship experience.

Master-programme: There is no substitute for experiencing international business culture first-hand. A key aspect of MBCi is the study trip in the final semester. Our students travel to international business hubs such as New York, London, and Hong Kong for an intense week of company visits, presentations, and business tours. They gain an invaluable perspective of doing business in these centres, learn about the local challenges and opportunities, as well as have interactive seminars with industry leaders.


